Cellar Notes

The grapes were machine harvested in the cool of evening to maximise flavour intensity and minimise oxidation, they were then crushed and gently pressed. The juice was settled until clear and fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks using aromatic yeast. Slow fermentation at low temperatures has retained the intense flavours of the grapes. Following fermentation the wine was lees stirred for four weeks to enhance texture and complexity.

Tasting Notes

Marlborough produces the world's finest Sauvignon Blanc. Our wines are produced by internationally renowned winemaker Alan McCorkindale. Meticulous vineyard management and innovative winemaking combine to produce a classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, intensely aromatic and lively, bursting with flavours of passionfruit, melon, gooseberry and citrus. It is dry with crisp acid and a typical herbaceous Marlborough pungency. The palate is dry and vibrant with racy acid and typical varietal pungency. The wine is lively and refreshing, finishing clean on the palate. Enjoy chilled as an aperitif, or match with fresh seafood.
